**PLEASE OBSERVE COURSE ETIQUETTE AND REPAIR ALL PITCH MARKS.
LOCAL BYE-LAWS**

- Reservoir 3rd Hole- if a ball lies within the defined area. Relief can be taken. Rule 24.
- Ground under Repair. Relief must be taken.
- Walls, in bounds, are an integral part of the course.
- Staked trees. If they interfere with player's stance or intended swing, relief may be taken. Rule 24-2.
- Players MUST give way to persons using the rights of way.
- The ditch on the right hand side of the 6th and the ditch behind the 7th green are lateral water hazards. Rule 26.1.
- Stones in bunkers are moveable obstructions. Rule 24-1.
- A ball striking the power lines or poles must be replayed from the spot where the ball was originally played.
- OUT OF BOUNDS (Rule 27-1) – Beyond any wall, fence, or hedge bounding the course. Beyond the perimeter fence of the quarry. (Holes 5, 10, 11 & 12).
- The 8th Hole is Out of Bounds, defined by white posts, when playing the 7th Hole. This does not apply when playing the 8th Hole. For your Health & Safety DO NOT cross any boundary wall, fence or hedge to retrieve a golf ball.
- The practice area can be defined by the closely mown area to the left of the first hole and may be used to warm up before any competition. Please note players using the practice area must give way to those playing the 1st hole.
- The General Committee have approved the use of distance measuring devices in Club Competitions. The use of devices that measure other conditions which might affect a play (e.g. wind or gradient are not permitted). Rule 14-3.
- All pathways with artificial surfaces shall be treated as immovable obstructions. Relief may be obtained under Rule 24-2.
